Position Title: Director of Youth/ Worship Ministries (DYWM)

Lead, develop and train our worship team(s) in leading our people to experience the presence of God through worship and connection with the world.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Youth Ministry: Develop, organize and lead the ministry of HFLC targeting Middle to High School aged youth in the HZ and their families. Formation of a Youth Board of adults who will resource, volunteer and help the DYWM. Develop and implement an annual youth ministry program including: outreach planning (including social media), activity planning, mission planning, fundraising, program administration planning and communications development.
- Worship Ministry- Assist/ lead planning the weekly contemporary worship service including: praise band coordination, audio/ video presentation selection and development, and the use/implementation of other uses of technology. Lead the worship team(s) for the contemporary worship service, including running rehearsals. This may include recruiting and training new worship team members (both adult and youth) as needed for weekly contemporary services and special youth and family centric events.

Critical Knowledge and Skills:

- Will have a contagious passion for Jesus and will demonstrate effective communication skills and the ability to recruit, engage, motivate and inspire youth
- Will encourage the spiritual development of youth so they come to know Jesus as their personal savior and grow and mature in their relationship with Christ
- The successful candidate will be a self-starter, not requiring a great deal of supervision. Candidate will possess a solid work ethic and willingness to do what it takes to get the job done.
- A working knowledge of Microsoft Office and experience interacting on major social media platforms is a must.
