

Jesus Loves Me, This I Know!






"I'm afraid God doesn't love me because I'm too young to matter."


"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."

"I'm afraid God doesn't love me because it seems like God didn't answer my prayer."


"But God has surely listened and heard my voice in prayer. Praise be to God, who has not rejected my prayer or withheld his love from me!"

"I'm afraid God doesn't love me because I'm not good enough."


"When the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of...things we had done, but because of his mercy."

"I'm afraid God doesn't love me because I don't have any friends."


Jesus says, "Greater love has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends. You are my friends." (John 15:13-14)



"I'm afraid God doesn't love me because sometimes love doesn't last. My parents got divorced."


"For the Lord is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations."

(Psalm 100:5)




"I'm afraid God doesn't love me because someone I trusted hurt me."

"Your love, O Lord, reaches to the heavens, your faithfulness to the skies." (Psalm 36:5)




"I'm afraid God doesn't love me because I'm always getting in trouble."
